Cadets

The young wolves were hungry at the very beginning of the race. In fact, the officials give an additional pre-race lap before giving the green flag. Vincent Roy took the pole position and managed to keep his place during the first laps. We were able to attend a beautiful fight between Benjamin Farran and Keven Hébert before this last one made a spin and meets himself in 4th position. In the last laps, the young Jacob Sévigny chased relentlessly the leader, Vincent Roy, to exceed him finally in the very last turn of the last lap, taking away at the same moment the race. Let us note that Keven Hébert finished third.

Honda Sr

The Boyt brothers, Jean-François and Nicolas respectively started 1st and 2nd but regrettably for this last one, he saw himself sliding behind from the first lap. During this time, we had a beautiful threeway fight between Jean-François Boyt, Alexandre Gauthier and Éric Beltrami. The fighting spirit of Beltrami (started 5th) finally carried fruit by bringing him in first position, place that he kept till the end. Gauthier finished second, followed by Jean-François Boyt in third.

Masters

Daniel Nadeau dashed of the position of head at first and ride lonely up to the finishing line without ever being in danger. From their part, Dany St-Hilaire and Camil Villeneuve engaged a beautiful fight for the 2nd position but it is finally St-Hilaire who cut the debate in the last lap with a beautiful overtaking. Villeneuve has to content himself with the third place.

Mini-Max

The pole position belonged to Samuel Fontaine who had to fight against a tough opponent in the person of Marc-Antoine Cardin. This last one chased the leader throughout the race, tempting multiple overtakings which stayed unsuccessfully. Fontaine takes away race but have been entitled to a beautiful opposition. Alexandre Fortin closes the podium in 3rd position.

Shifter

Étienne Lasalle started first but was quickly overtaken by Olivier Sirois from the beginning. Lasalle and Sirois exchanged the first place on several occasions in what would be advisable to call the most beautiful fight of the day. Jean-François Valour then joined the leaders, managing even to seize the 2nd place, taking advantage of what seemed to be a transmission's problem for Lasalle. It is finally Sirois who takes away the honors of the race, followed by Valour in 2nd and by Daniel Nadeau in 3rd.

Rotax Jr

It is very determined Josiane Plante who started first, followed by Jordan Fiset and Michael Pelletier. However, a hard exit of track of this last one deprived him from any hope of victory. Plante, aggressive but in control, realized a perfect race until the young Fiset takes advantage of a slight opening to take the head in the last lap, the position that he kept till the end. Plante, apparently disappointed, finished 2nd while Keagan Doblesteam ends in third place.
